

Snow White and Rose Red - little sachets



Materials

- small amount of fingering weight approx. 420m/100g (shown here in Tausendschön Sockenwolle colour „Moorhuhn“ and a undyed version of sockyarn)
- 1 set of double Point needles size 2,75mm,
- 1 crochet hook size 2,5mm
- Marker,
- Ribbon

Gauge isn't really necessary for that project, Needlesize and number of stitches are also variable.

Pattern

Cast on 54 stitches with two needles holding together .

Divide stitches evenly on 3 needles and join to round. (if necessary place marker to indicate beginning of round)

1.-4. Round: Knit

Next Round: (Eyelets): *1K, 1YO, 2Ktog* repeat

Next Round and every following Round: Knit

Finishing & Crocheted Edge

When Sachet reaches desired length divide stitches evenly on two needles and close bottom of sachet with kitcheners stitch (invisible seam).

Edge: Ch3, *1sc in next stitch, skip next stitch, ch3, sc in next stitch* repeat all round.

Weave in loose ends and thread ribbon through eyelets.

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Feel free to knit as many sachets as you like, but please don't sell pattern or sachets.
